

## CLOX N. GIBBS 1863 Upg 55 by 3:03

The members of Allen County Indiana Bar Association assemble to pay tribute to one of its respected members, Cloy M. Gibbs, who died unexpectedly April 18, 1963, after an honorable career at the Bar and in the service of this community.

Cloy M. Gibbs was a native of Wauseon, Ohio. He received his early education in the public schools of Wauseon. Early in life he entered the editorial field of journalism and was associated with one of the Auburn, Indiana, newspapers.

For many years he cherished the ambition of becoming a lawyer and during his spare moments away from the editorial desk devoted his time to the study of law. He supplemented his study with courses in LaSalle University Law School and was admitted to the Bar in 1935. He came to our city in 1938 and until the time of his death practiced his profession in Fort Wayne. His efforts were directed primarily to civil matters.

In prestice Cloy was a faithful member of the Democratic Party and on several occasions served with credit to his profession as an interim appointed in the office of the Justice of the Peace of Wayne Township, Allen County, Indiana.

He possessed an amiable disposition and was level to his family, his friends and his olientele.

He was a member of various bodies of the Masonic Order, the United Commercial Travelers, Allen County Indiana Bar Association, Indiana State Bar Association and the Grade Lutheran Church of Fort Wayne.

He is survived by his wife, Lydia Rodenbeck Gibbs; a son, Dr. LeGrand Gibbs, of Mansfield, Ohio, and four (4) grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Sunday, April 21, 1963, with burial in Concordia Lutheran Cemetery, this City.
