

WILLIAM P. ENDICOTT

IN MEMORIAM

William P. Endicott, an esteemed member of our profession, has passed from our midst. It is, therefore, fitting that the members of the Allen County Bar Association pay tribute at this time to our distinguished neighbor from DeKalb County.

At the time of his death, Judge Endicott was 72 years of age. Although he spent the early part of his life in the State of Texas, the greater portion of his life was spent in the State of Indiana. He attended Indiana University, and later was a teacher at this same institution. He first practiced law in the town of Butler, Indiana, but he subsequently moved to Auburn and resided there until the time of his death.

Judge Endicott was a personable and able gentlemen, and highly regarded by his colleagues in the law profession. He was not only a devoted lawyer, but a devoted Judge as well. He was originally Judge of the old DeKalb Steuben Circuit Court, and thereafter he served as Judge of the DeKalb Circuit Court for four terms. He was noted for his devotion ~~to~~ the cause at hand, as well as for the warmth and understanding toward those who brought their problems to him.

Judge Endicott was a member and past President of the DeKalb County Bar Association, a past President of the Auburn Lions Club, a member of the Masonic and Knights of Pythias Lodges in DeKalb County and the Scottish Rite and Shrine here in Fort Wayne. He was also a member of the Chamber of Commerce and the Methodist Church.






