LESTER B. HARPER

Lester B. Harper, who practiced law in Fort Wayne for 40 years prior to 1959, died in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, on Sunday, May 9, 1971.

He is survived by his widow, Mary, and three sons and a daughter. To his family, the Allen County, Indiana Bar Association extends its profound sympathy.

When Mr. Harper retired and left Fort Wayne in 1959, the community lost a genuinely civic-minded citizen who gave his time and considerable talent to the religious, educational, and charitable activities of the community. Mr. Harper was a competent and scholarly student of the law and practiced his profession with a high degree of dedication to his clients and his profession.
