George E. Glass was born in Bluffton, Indiana,
September 19th, 1905, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Dal Glass;
In 1933 Mr. Glass graduated from the law college of

His assidious practice of the law at Bluffton and his delightfully pleasing personality were impelling factors in his election as prosecuting attorney in Wells County, Indiana; his tenure in this office was replete with success and distinction;

For the past several years he was a highly esteemed and beloved member of this, the Allen County Per;

During World War II he devoted considerable time to armanent work; it may well be said of George E. Glass that he, too, was a war casualty, for his labours most likely contributed to the impairment of his health;

In this City and this area he had a host of friends; one became his friend upon first sight;

And he was ever a fighter for the cause of friend and client;

About George E. Glass that part of the poem by Robert Browning entitled "PROSPICE" may well be quoted:

"I was a fighter, so—one fight more,

The best and the last!

I would hate that death bandaged my eyes, and forbore, And bade se creep past.

No! let me taste the whole of it, fare like my peers The heroes of old,

Rear the brunt, in a minute pay glad life's arroars of pain, darkness and cold.

For sudden the worst turns the best to the breve, The black minute's at end,

For the elements' rage, the fiend-voices that rave, Shall dwindle, shall blend,

Shall change, shall become first a peace out of pain, Then a light, then thy breast,

O thou soul of my soul! I shall clasp thee again, And with God be the rest!"

Now, Therefore, be it resolved by the members of the Allen County Bar that we dieply regret the passing of Ar. Glass and extend to his widow, Mary Ellen, and his daughter, Sandra Ann, and his twin brother Gerald and his brother Kenneth, and his parents, our profound sympathy in their bereavement.
