## MRMORIAL RESOLUTION OF THE ALLEN COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION

## DAVID S. VESEY

Mr. President, members of the Allen County Bar Association and friends.

With his passing, a long family relationship with this association and legal affairs in this community came to an end.

David's father was Judge of the Allen Superior Court at the turn of the century. The Judge and his brother practiced law in partnership during the early part of the 20th Century, and David S.

Vesey joined this family partnership upon his graduation from the University of Michigan in 1913. David stayed in the active practice until about 1923 when he stopped to smell the flowers along the way and decided he preferred the beauty of working with flowers to the symmetrical logic of dealing with interpersonal relationships in the field of law. He substantially left the practice of law to manage the family floral business. Since that time in 1923 he maintained an interest in legal affairs by maintaining his membership in our association, but substantially confined his practice to family representation.

In his chosen field, he was a leader and served as President of the Indiana State Florists Association. He was also active in the 100 Percent Club and the Old Friars. He belonged to the First Christian Church, Home Lodge 342, F&AM, Mizpah Shrine Temple and Mystic Shrine.

David was a devoted family man, and left surviving, his widow Lela and two daughters, Mrs. Richard Woolery of Bedford and Mrs.

Oscar Eggers of Prairie Village, Kansas. Two sisters also survive him.

We join with the family in mourning his passing and express our deepest sympathy to the family.

Mr. President, I move that the Allen County Bar Association give public expression of the sorrow of its members upon the death of David S. Vesey;

That a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to his widow Lela and family;

That a copy of this Resolution be spread of record in the permanent records of the Courts of Allen County, Indiana, to evidence the respect and affection of the members of the Association for its departed brother.
